# Kanban Values and Principles

Remember that kanban is aimed at process improvement and usually has a wider view than the team view (unless the organization is small).

## Values

- Start with what you do now
- Agree to pursue incremental, evolutionary change
- Initially, respect current roles, responsibilities & job titles
- Encourage acts of leadership at all levels of your organization

## Principles

- Visualize
- Limit WIP
- Manage Flow
- Make Process Policies Explicit
- Implement Feedback Loops
- Improve Collaboratively
- Evolve Experimentally (using models/scientific method)
