- Base Milestones on Object Evaluation of Working Systems
- Visualize and Limit WIP (work-in-progress), Reduce Batch Size, and Manage Queue Lengths
- Apply Cadence, Synchronize with Cross-Domain Planning
- Unlock the Intrinsic Motivation of Knowledge Workers
- De-Centralize Decision Making
